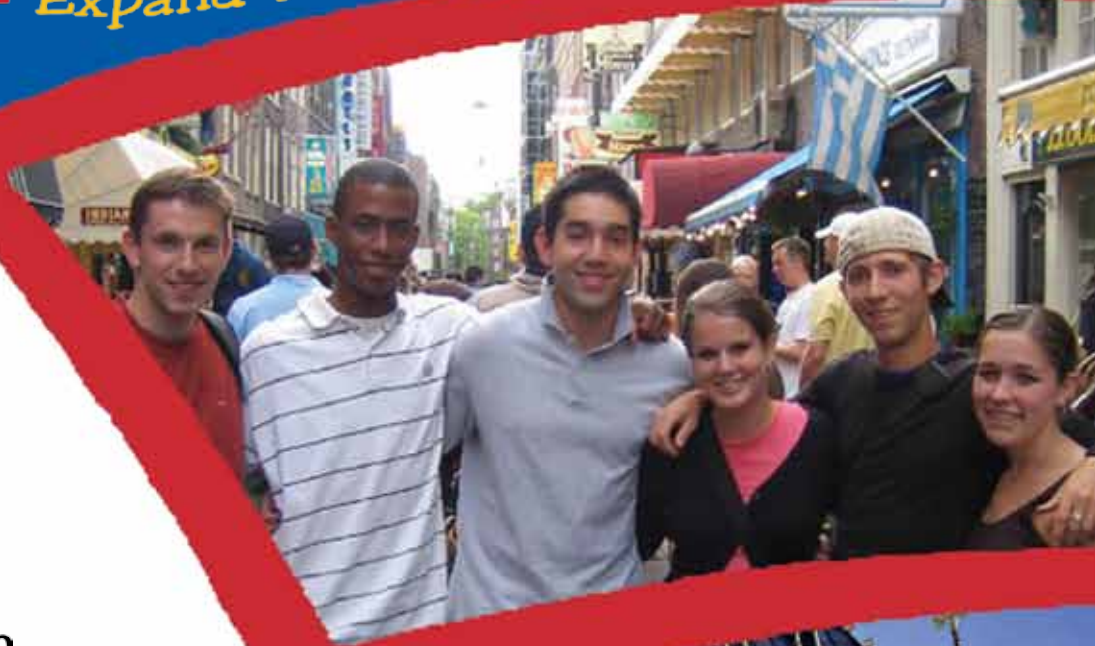

DAY 1 TRAVEL TO LONDON

Embark on your overnight flight to London. [In-flight Meals]

DAY 2 LONDON

Free afternoon, followed by our welcome orientation and pub dinner. [D]

DAY 3 LONDON

Big Ben, Buckingham Palace and Piccadilly Circus: These familiar names become familiar places on our morning tour. Afternoon at leisure—take in the city's monuments or embark on a shopping spree. Why not attend a West End theater show tonight? [B]

DAY 4 LONDON

Enjoy a day at leisure in London. Explore the British Museum, the National Gallery or the London Dungeons. After dusk, you may want to take in some Shakespeare at the Globe Theater. [B]

DAY 5 LONDON * EUROSTAR TRAIN TO PARIS

Travel through the "Chunnel" below the English Channel, to Paris. Our local art historian shows us the Arc de Triomphe, the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame Cathedral and Place de la Concorde, where the guillotine once stood. Tonight, dine on French specialties at our bistro dinner. Afterward, take a romantic cruise down the river Seine. [B,D]

DAY 6 PARIS* *Optional Cabaret show*

Free day in Paris: Included Paris Museum Pass allows access to over 70 museums and monuments in and around Paris including the world famous Louvre, housing the Mona Lisa, Musée d'Orsay, Musée National Picasso and the Châteaux de Versailles. Consider an optional Cabaret show tonight. [B]

DAY 7 OVERNIGHT TRAIN TO ROME

This morning consider exploring Paris' fabulous stores, stroll through the artists' section of Montmartre, or browse the bookstalls on the Left Bank. On our free afternoon mingle with the rich and famous at "Fouquet's" café on the Champs-Élysées. In the evening we board our overnight express train to Italy. [B]

DAY 8 ROME

Check in to our hotel and enjoy an afternoon at leisure exploring Rome. Tonight, join us for our Viva Italia Pizza Party. Following dinner, perhaps walk to Piazza Navona, one of the city's most beautiful Baroque squares, and try the local gelati. [B,D]

DAY 9 ROME

This morning see the historic ruins of Caesar's Forum and the Colosseum where gladiators fought. A trip across the Tiber River takes us to Vatican City, where we'll visit St. Peter's Basilica. Free afternoon—make sure to visit the Vatican Museum to see the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel. An evening on your own might include a visit to the Trevi Fountain—toss in three coins to ensure your return to Rome. [B]

DAY 10 ROME

The entire day is free for exploring the Eternal City. Shop on Via Condotti, or visit more of the historical and artistic sights in the city. Tonight, dine on Italian delicacies, and listen to live music at our fun Roman banquet. [B,D]

DAY 11 SORRENTO PENINSULA

Motor on through sunny olive groves lining the way south to the Sorrento peninsula. Perched on the cliffs above the blue gulf of Naples, this is where Ulysses resisted the call of the Sirens in Homer's "Odyssey." Enjoy a free evening in Sorrento. [B]

DAY 12 POMPEII * OVERNIGHT SHIP TO GREECE

Travel to Pompeii, the city buried in 79 A.D. by 20 feet of ashes and lava after

Mt. Vesuvius' volcanic eruption. After our tasty lunch, we continue across the Italian "boot" and board our overnight ship to Greece. [B,L]

DAY 13, 14 & 15 GREEK ISLAND CENTER * *Optional Kaiki Sailing Trip*

Cruising through aquamarine waters, our ship docks at Patras. Motor along the Corinthian Sea across the Peloponnese to Galatas and the island of Poros. Relax with three days of living like a Greek god—swim, sunbathe or take part in optional activities such as waterskiing, wakeboarding, parasailing, banana-boating or tubing. We invite you to our farewell toga party on the last night. [B,D], [B,D], [B,D]

DAY 16 ATHENS * *Optional Greek taverna dinner*

In the morning we board our ferry to Athens. Visit the 2400-year-old Parthenon and the Temple of Zeus overlooking the Acropolis. Afterwards there's free time to wander through the markets of Monastiraki. Enjoy a leisure evening in Athens or follow the sounds of traditional bouzouki music and join our optional Taverna dinner in the Plaka District—Athens' oldest neighborhood—at the foot of the Acropolis. [B]

DAY 17 TRAVEL HOME

Reluctantly we say farewell to Europe and newfound friends. Jet back home with thoughts of planning your next European adventure! [B, In-flight Meals]

The Classic Europe tour is a great value and offers:

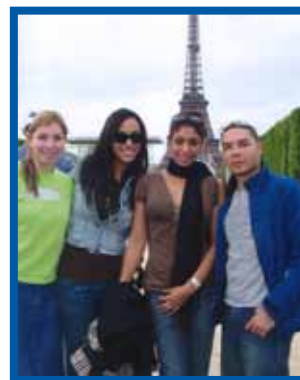
- The opportunity for fun, hassle-free travel with other graduates

Terms and Conditions

EXCLUSIONS: These prices do not include passport and, if applicable, visa fees (Depending on your nationality, you may require visas in addition to a passport to enter certain countries. You must contact appropriate consulates for details on how to obtain on your own.); airport and government taxes; tipping of tour guide and driver (suggested: driver \$3 per day; tour director \$4 per day); beverages with meals unless indicated otherwise; laundry; personal insurance; room service; telephone charges; all items of a personal nature; porterage; airport transfers when a participant deviates from scheduled flights or travel dates; private transportation; and all items not specifically stated in the itinerary.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All cancellations must be received by AESU Alumni World Travel in writing. All cancellations for any reason whatsoever will be subject to a \$300 per person cancellation fee. Date of receipt will determine penalties assessed. In addition to \$300, cancellation between 60 - 31 days of departure will result in forfeiture of 25% of tour cost; between 30 - 16 days 40%. Cancellation within 15 days or "no show" at the time of departure will result in forfeiture of the entire cost of the trip. AIRFARES are highly restrictive, NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-ENDORSABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE once ticketed. Once reservation is booked and paid for AESU Alumni World Travel reserves the right to issue tickets. Once ticketed, airfare portion is non-refundable. Cancellation of airfare reservations is subject to restrictions, regulations and additional penalties of the airlines used. Reservation changes also subject to penalties. Medical health and accident insurance is compulsory.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS & BAGGAGE: All participants using AESU Alumni World Travel flights on regular group departure days and flights receive airport transfers (between airport & tour hotel) overseas. London Gatwick arrivals please call AESU (800.638.7640) for details on transfer. Inter-airport transfers (i.e. between London Gatwick-Heathrow) are at passenger's expense. Land-Only participants (providing own flight to Europe) do NOT receive airport transfers and must meet group at the first hotel after 1:00 p.m. on program start date. All programs start in Europe ONE DAY LATER THAN the USA departure dates listed. Participants should limit themselves to one checked bag per person and one carry-on per person. Liability is clearly stated on the passenger contract.

RESPONSIBILITY: The responsibility of AESU Alumni World Travel and the Sponsoring Association is limited. They act only in the capacity of agents for the passenger in all matters pertaining to accommodations, sightseeing and transportation whether by railroad, motorboat, motorcar, steamship or plane, and as such they shall not be liable for any personal injury, death, damage, loss, accident, delay or irregularity which may be occasioned, whether by reason of any defect in any vehicle, or through the acts or default of any company or person engaged in conveying the passenger, or in carrying out the arrangement of the tour. They can accept no responsibility for strike, war, quarantine, weather and any other natural or unnatural causes. Additional expenses, if incurred under any of these circumstances, will be borne by the tour participant. By forwarding the deposit, the passenger certifies that he/she has no physical, mental or other condition or disability that would create a hazard for himself/herself or other passengers & accepts the terms of this contract. The right is reserved to decline, accept or retain any person as a member of the tour or to cancel or alter the tour as required. If improvements in the itinerary can be made, or unforeseen conditions beyond AESU Alumni World Travel's control make changes necessary, they reserve the right to alter itineraries without penalty. Trip cancellation insurance should be purchased by the individual traveler in the event cancellation of the tour is compelled by circumstances beyond our control. In the event of cancellation due to insufficient number of participants, AESU Alumni World Travel's liability shall be limited to a FULL REFUND of all payments received from applicants, except non-refundable airfare and insurance. Baggage and personal injury are at owner's risk entirely. The issuance or acceptance of vouchers or tickets shall be considered consent of the above conditions.
